FINANCIAL COMMITMENTS

Application Fee

A one-time, non-refundable **Application Fee of \$25.00** is due upon submission of application. Application can be completed online at www.victoryoutreach.org. Upon completion of your application, it will be submitted for approval. Once application is approved, you will receive an approval email which will include a username and password. At this time you are now ready to pay for your tuition online at www.victoryoutreach.org

Tuition Fee : East Coast, West Coast, Mexico and South Africa

Six (6) Month Tuition (Paid in Full)	\$2,500.00 (applicable for consecutive sessions)
One (1) Year Tuition (Paid in Full)	\$4,800.00 (applicable for consecutive session)
Six (6) Month Recurring Tuition	\$1800 and a monthly mandatory recurring tuition of \$300 for 3 months to be set up to be paid during your first 3 months
One (1) Year Recurring Tuition	\$2400 and a monthly mandatory recurring tuition of \$400 for 6 months to be set up to be paid during your first 6 months

IMPORTANT:

South Africa UTC : Student is solely responsible to obtain the proper VISA and documentation. Student is responsible to have in advance VISA documentation approved prior to extending their stay. **NO REFUNDS** will apply.

Please be advised that if the mandatory recurring goes into default, due to Non-sufficient funds the prepaid tuition is forfeited and you will have to return home.
